NATIONAL DAY OF AWARENESS FOR MMIWG2S+

This campaign is part of our collective response to the 231 Calls for Justice from the National Inquiry into Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women, Girls, and 2SLGBTQ+ People (MMIWG2S+). **Every red dress is a symbol of a life taken too soon, and a voice that must never be forgotten.**

From Red Dress Day (May 5) to Sisters in Spirit Day (October 4) and all year long, we invite communities, organizations, schools, and individuals to take part in this visible act of remembrance and resistance.

HOW TO TAKE ACTION:

- **Display a red dress** in a window, yard, or entrance to honour lives lost (carefully and securely with this poster, please ensure that your red dress can not blow, away, fall down, be removed or damaged - they are sacred).
- **Tie a red ribbon around a tree** in your yard or neighbourhood as a symbol of remembrance.
- **Participate in ceremony on May 5** (National MMIWG2S+ Awareness Day). Visit Grandmother's Voice to learn more and get involved
- **Sign the petition** to support a Living Monument for MMIWG2S+. Demand that all levels of government fulfill the recommendations of the National Inquiry

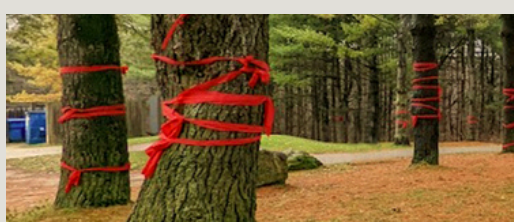
